

Highway 2

WIDENING PROJECT

Highway 2 will be widened from two to four lanes between E. 72nd Avenue and I-76, providing dedicated bicycle lanes and improving pedestrian access. The area of Highway 2 between E. 112th Avenue and I-76 is being constructed as part of the new recreation center project.



Features

- Widen from two to four lanes
- Dedicated bicycle lanes
- Acceleration, deceleration, turn lanes
- LED street lighting
- In-pavement lighting/reflectors
- Multi-use trail
- Raised and landscaped median
- Landscape improvements
- Improved drainage

Goals

- Increase vehicle capacity
- Improve safety
- Reduce flooding and improve water quality
- Accommodate pedestrians, bicyclists, vehicles
