

Tower Road WIDENING PROJECT



The Tower Road widening project is one of five projects in Commerce City's voter-approved capital improvement program.



Features

- Widen from two to four lanes with dedicated bicycle lanes on both sides
- Acceleration, deceleration, turn lanes
- LED street lighting
- Traffic signals at 81st, 88th and 96th avenues
- Culvert crossing with provisions for trail underpass at Second Creek
- Detention and water quality ponds
- Raised and landscaped median
- Underground the overhead electric lines
- 6-foot wide sidewalk
- 10-foot wide multi-purpose path

Goals

- Increase vehicle capacity
- Improve safety
- Higher level of service
- Eliminate roadway flooding and improve water quality
- Environmentally sensitive/contextually sensitive
- Multi-modal: accommodate pedestrians, bicyclists and vehicles

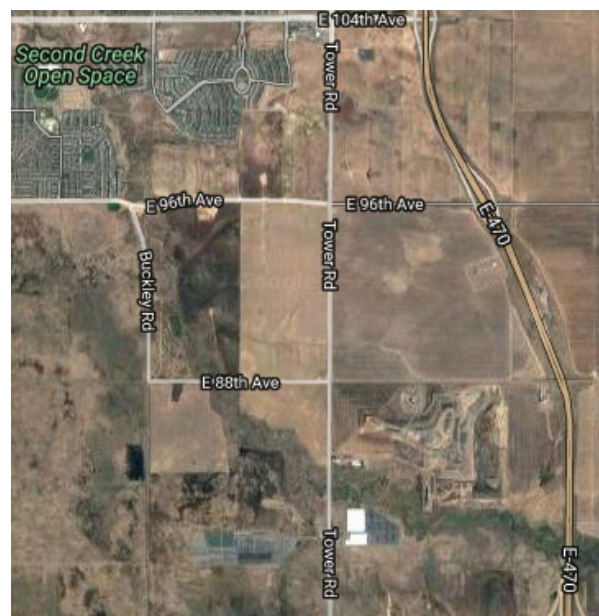
