


## BUFFALO RUN Clubhouse Improvements

Project Overview



## **Project Scope**

The Buffalo Run Golf Course originally opened in 1996. The purpose of remodeling the 20-year-old clubhouse was to increase revenue potential and provide aesthetic enhancements for the aging facility. The layout of the building was modified to improve space use without adding additional square footage. The scope of the remodel included moving the conference room from the front of the building to be adjacent to the dining room, creating additional dining space and improving service efficiency. The Golf Shop was reconfigured to add retail space and the lavatory facilities were increased in size and updated. Interior finishes and furnishings were also updated.


