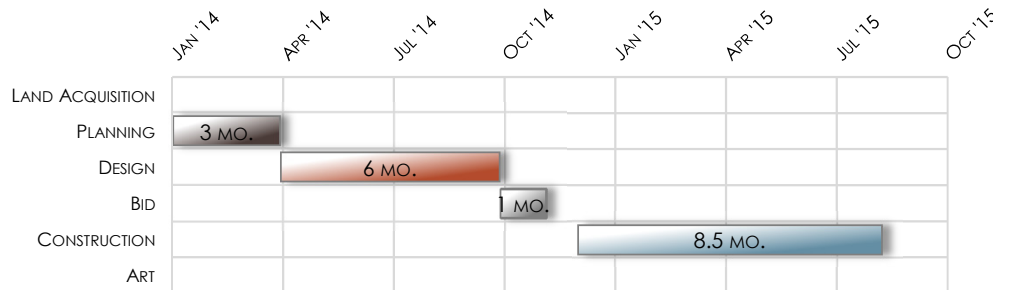
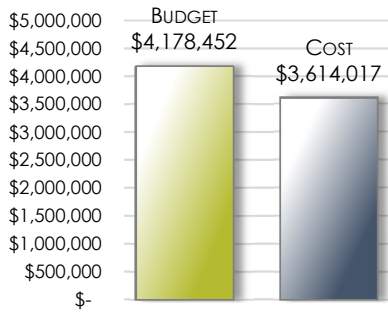


Project Scope

Fronterra Neighborhood Park was one of five projects in Commerce City's voter-approved capital improvement program. The project scope comprised planning, design and construction of a 20-acre neighborhood park including picnic and restroom facilities, playground equipment, climbing boulders, walking/jogging trails, fitness stations, skate area, multi-use hard court, and two graded playfields. The park was designed to incorporate sustainable landscaping principles and includes low-level lighting intended to enhance safety while limiting light pollution. The park was officially opened to the public in August 2015.

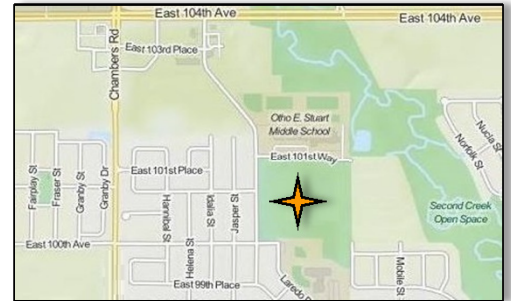
