
PROJECT FACT SHEET





Highway 2 Median Design from E. 72nd Ave. to I-76

About the Project

Commerce City is redesigning and constructing medians on Highway 2 between E. 72nd Avenue and I-76, spanning approximately seven and a half miles. As one of Colorado's fastest growing cities, Commerce City's goal for the project is to enhance safety and improve traffic operations along this segment, with a focus on median designs.

The project improvements for better mobility and increased safety will include:

- Restriping and improving signage for bikers/ other sidewalk and trail users in the area.
- Construct buffer/raised median in various locations along the corridor.
- Redesigning medians within the corridor.
- The addition of pedestrian signing, striping, and flashing beacons.
- Evaluate traffic bottlenecks on E. 96th Street
 and E. 104th Street
- Assess ways for speed limit compliance by motorists.

Project Goals and Objectives

- The median design will improve mobility and enhance safety on the corridor for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians.
- Improvements will be made to medians, bike lanes, and there will be additional safety features for pedestrians.
- Signage will be improved, and the roads will be restriped.
