In 2013, Commerce City's voters approved a 1 percent sales and use tax increase for new parks, recreation and road projects. The ballot measure was a result of a two-year, community-driven process to identify how to implement programs and services that address growing population needs, achieve vision and build a better Commerce City.

The sales tax increase is a dedicated funding source for the city's capital improvement program for new parks, recreation and road projects. Through participation from residents, businesses and city council, the City's vision of a Quality Community for a Lifetime is realized with improved mobility, greater access and increased recreational opportunities.

The new recreation center is one of five projects funded by the 1 percent sales and use tax increase approved by voters in 2013 to build, operate and maintain five projects over the next five years. The projects include:

- Three new neighborhood parks
- Widening of Tower Road from E. 80th to E. 103rd avenues
- New additions to Eagle Pointe Recreation Center
- Paradice Island Pool at Pioneer Park
- Bison Ridge Recreation Center

The new Bison Ridge Recreation Center is located at 13905 E. 112th Ave., Commerce City, CO 80022.

The 108,000-square-foot building features:

- Indoor pool
- Pool party rooms
- Gymnasium with elevated walking/jogging track
- Three basketball, volleyball and pickleball courts
- Group fitness rooms
- Weight/Fitness area with outdoor yoga and cardio space
- Gymnastics center with in-ground trampoline, three vault runways, and spring flooring
- Family locker rooms
- Child watch area
- Catering kitchen
- Community wing with event space for 300 people
- Technological commons area
- Approximately 350 parking spaces
- Site infrastructure, road and utility work
